At Love Kare Trust (LKT) Foundation, it is this spirit we celebrate. Thank you for being there with us in this journey of seeking love, hope and strength for those who need it.

Your invaluable support helped get us on our feet last year. In 2018, Love Kare Trust Foundation was registered under Switzerland's leading umbrella foundation- Fondation Des Fondateurs (translated as 'Foundation of the Founders') based in Zurich, Switzerland. With this, LKT foundation joins several leading NGOs of Switzerland in adopting common standards based on strong governance, transparency, efficiency and a desire to bring positive change.

Last year, we also entered into a formal partnership with Mudita- our partner NGO based in Pune, India. With a strong operational presence on the ground, Mudita is and will continue to help LKT Foundation in achieving the ultimate objective of the foundation- to support the patients suffering from cancer and their families.

With a strong organizational set up in place and through your continued support, LKT Foundation supported four families last year. We disbursed close to CHF 10000 towards supporting the expenses of their medical treatment including chemotherapies, surgeries and PET/CT scans (more details below).

While we are proud of the progress we have been able to achieve through your support, we remain mindful of the need to build on this progress and do much more to achieve impact at scale.

To achieve this, we need to be responsible custodian of the financial resources you and others have kindly entrusted to us. For that reason, we share with you our progress report from our inception till date. We hope that this gives you a clear and an accurate picture of what we have been able to achieve so far.

It is an honor for all of us to join forces with you in our mission of supporting those who are fighting cancer. We may not be able to defeat it for now, but we can definitely stand together against it.

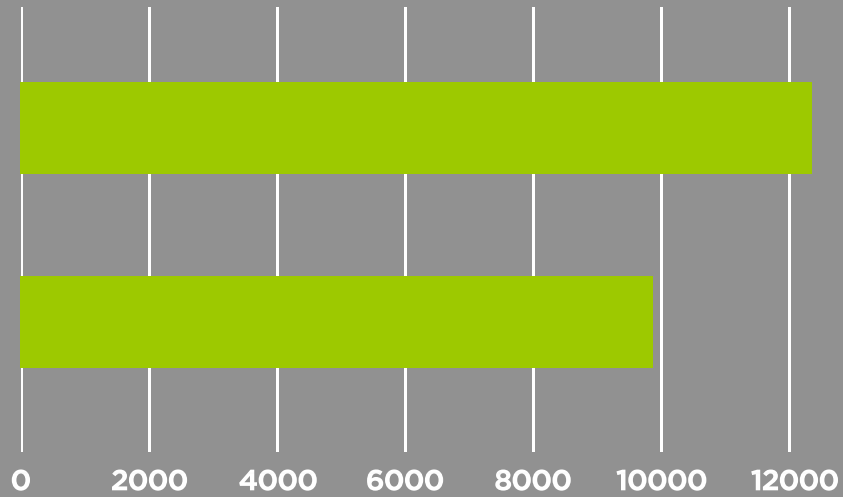

LATE YOGINDER SINGH BHADORIYA 39 YEARS OLD FARMER FROM BHIND EWING SARCOMA



Yoginder was the first fighter supported by Love Kare trust Foundation in partnership with Mudita. His family lives in a small town in Uttar Pradesh called Bhind. He visited Pune for treatment while being supported by his sister living in Daund, a neighbouring City of Pune. His 3 children go to the village school in Bhind.

He complained of pain and was undergoing diagnostic scans of a potential relapse in October 2017. Once the relapse was confirmed, the doctors informed him of his prognosis and the estimate for his treatment. Yoginder could not afford his treatment and the livelihood for his family at the same time. He therefore, gave up the former.

Fortunately, this is also when LKT & Mudita were looking out to help and after our due diligence, we started supporting Yoginder. After withstanding close to 8 chemotherapy cycles and a surgery, Yoginder was declared free from Cancer in May 2018.

It was the indomitable human spirit and the power of hope, that had triumphed.

The fight far from over, Yoginder was again under treatment after new metastases were diagnosed in early 2019. LKT & Mudita continued to support Yoginder in the available capacity and we also networked with other NGOs to arrange support for him.

The last few months were particularly challenging for his family due to the progression of his disease. He could not take all the prescribed Chemotherapies as his health deteriorated.

As the days passed, he chose to spend more time with his family than traveling long distance for treatment. Now indeed the time was near. On the 13th of October 2019, after a 2 year long fight since we met Yoginder, he departed for heavenly abode.

We pray for the peace of his soul and strength to his family in these testing times.

LATE MR. SHRIKANT TIWARI
43 YEARS OLD SUPPORT ENGINEER FROM PUNE
COLON CANCER



When Mudita was approached for Mr Shrikant, he had just stopped working for his company due to the illness. While working as a Support Engineer, Shrikant was the lone bread earner in his family with wife, 2 children and aging parents.

Initial prognosis prescribed 6 chemotherapies but due to the side effects and onset of weakness Shrikant had to postpone a few weeks. Meanwhile, Shrikant's family also tried Alternative therapy treatment but his health only kept deteriorating.

In March 19 again, chemotherapy was restarted however Shrikant's body and mind had taken enough already. For a person once full of life and living a respectable life only to take care of his family, Shrikant was a mere shadow of himself.

We lost Shrikant on 23rd of May 2019 to Cancer. May his soul Rest in Peace.

Priyanka (Late Mr. Shrikant's wife) has faced the challenges with immense grace and courage. She continues to be positive in her outlook towards life and is looking for a job to support her family.

LKT also started supporting the education of Late Mr Shrikant's children from this year. We have sponsorship for Shrikant's family from an individual donor who stepped up to support the Tiwari family. We can only express our gratitude to our sponsor, the team of Mudita and LKT who have worked extremely hard in supporting this family with a heartfelt "Thank you".

SHIRISHA YADAV
35 YEARS OLD SINGLE MOTHER FROM PUNE
BREAST CANCER



Shirisha is an inspirational story in today's world of how a woman can withstand incredible challenges.

Coming from a financially weak background, Shirisha faced challenges in her life early on. Her husband met with a car accident and passed away in 2011 leaving 2 small girls in her lap. With little support from her family, Shirisha continued her journey.

The next jolt was to be diagnosed with Breast cancer herself. This time her father and brother supported her in the treatment and again, she came out triumphant. However, her test is still not over.

In February of 2019, Shirisha had a relapse and underwent a surgery. Her support funds ran out and she looked for help.

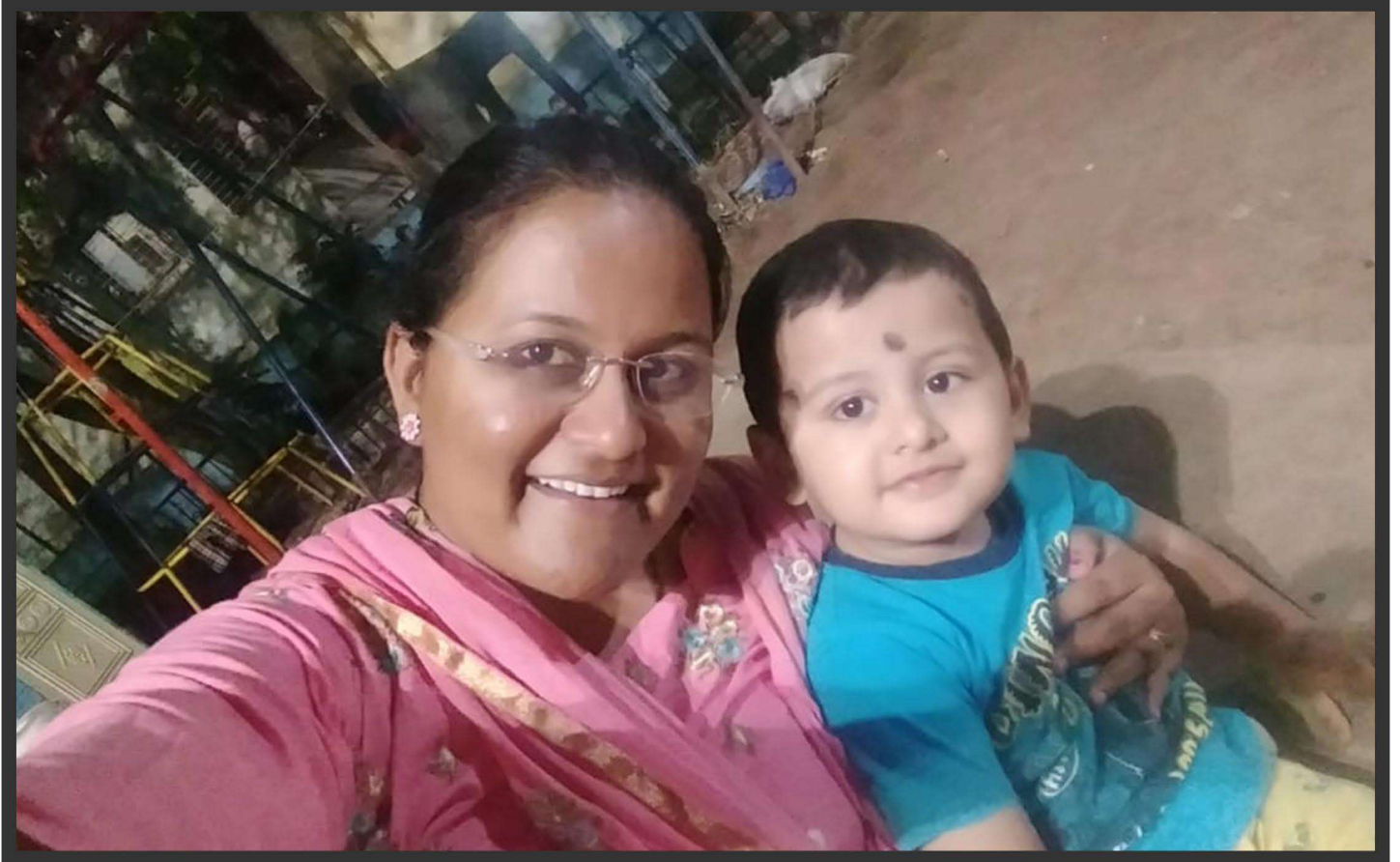

32 YEARS OLD SINGLE MOTHER FROM PUNE
BREAST CANCER



Sonal is a loving mother of a 2.5 year old son. At a time when we can barely see beyond the next steps our children are taking, Sonal was thrust into a fight for survival for herself and her young son.

To make matters more challenging for her, her husband left her on her own to navigate through the rough waters. Sonal, not the one to give up, underwent a surgery and has undergone 4 chemotherapy cycles and is positive about her vigil.

LKT is also supporting the Schooling & day care costs for Sonal's son. We look for partial or full sponsorship for Sonal in her testing times.



PLAN FOR THE COMING YEAR

In 2017-18, we set out with three objectives-

- a) to set up an organization based in trust and transparency
- b) to establish on-ground mechanisms to reach our ultimate beneficiaries
- c) to begin to provide direct support to them.

With your support, we have been able to achieve this.

For the coming year, we aim to continue this while intending to scale up to reach more beneficiaries while also including other modes of support besides direct financial support towards the patient's medical expenses.

Our targets for the year 2019-20 are as follows:

1. To support at least 10 patients and their families towards their medical expenses
2. To support the education expenses of the children of at least three families
3. To at least double the amounts of funds raised from the previous year

None of this will be possible without your continued support, encouragement and association. With you all, we look forward to a great year ahead.
